

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Infusing You Tube into NICHE Curriculum



Promotes deep learning & improves class experience
 Active learning strategy
 Increases engagement in the class
 Improves critical thinking & awareness
 Visionizations of elders circumstances resonates & inspires the nurses, motivating change agents
 on the unit
 Supports the Domain of Learning (Cognitive, Psychomotor & Affective)

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Affective Domain of Learning
(emotional/ attitudes/feelings)



Aim is to **CHANGE** attitudes & feeling


Changing and internalizing the way one views the world into a their personal philosophy

An avenue to Infuse **HUMANITY** back into geriatric nursing



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Affective Domain of Learning

Classified according to the depth of emotional response from the learner from less complex to more complex

- Receiving** the learner passively aware, listens and is attentive
- Responding** the learner reacts in some manner
- Valuing** the learner associates a value with their belief system
- Organization** the learner assimilates the values and ideas
- Characterization** the learner values into a personal philosophy
